Attendance for students with SEND at City Academy continues to be strong and is currently at **89.4% against a school average of 92.05%**. It is vital that students attend right up until the final day of school on the 19th December, if you need support to ensure students can attend or are punctual, please contact us immediately and we can support with routine plans, journey routes and bus passes,

We have a breakfast club that begins at 0745am should your child like to come to school to eat, study and socialise before school begins at 0835.
