Every student in Years 7 and 8 at City Academy has five 50-minute lessons a week of English, Mathematics and Science.

Additionally, each student has six 50-minute lessons a week of 'Literacy For Life,' where they study a combination of History, Religious Studies, Geography and Citizenship.

Students also have two 50-minute lessons a week of Spanish, Art, Performing Arts, Design Technology and Physical Education.

Finally, all students have one 50-minute lesson a week of Computing.

In Year 9, all students study:

- English
- Mathematics

- Spanish

- PSHE

Every student in Year 9 at City Academy has five 50-minute lessons a week of English, Mathematics and Science.

Additionally, each student has six 50-minute lessons a week of Humanities, this includes two lessons of History, two lessons of Religious Studies and two lessons of Geography.

Students also have two 50-minute lessons a week of Spanish, Art, Performing Arts, Design Technology and Physical Education.

Finally, all students have one 50-minute lesson a week of Computing.



In year 10, all students study:

Students then select one subject from the following option blocks:

- Option C French, Spanish, Creative iMedia
