I am pleased to report the behaviour data for this week. There are 413 students that have received no negative behaviour points this week, and 618 students who have received positive behaviour points. The year group with the most positive behaviour points this week are Year 8, with 1247 positive behaviour points awarded. Please discuss this continued positive change in behaviour at City Academy with your children. I would like to remind families that all behaviour and attendance information for your children can be found by logging onto **Class Charts**. If you do not have access to Class Charts, please contact us on <u>enquiries@corecity.academy</u>, so we can support you to access this information.

In addition, based on student voice from our elected student leaders, we have now opened our Rewards Shop. The student leaders have discussed what motivational rewards that we should have available. The Rewards Shop is available on **Class Charts** for students to spend their positive behaviour points. Please speak to your child about the Rewards Shop.

Yesterday we welcomed year 8 families to Parents Evening. It was a very positive evening, with high levels of engagement from all families in attendance.
