Teachers' Industrial Action – Spring Term 2023

As shared with you last week, the National Education Union (NEU) voted in favour of industrial action by their members. The union has informed us that there would be a series of strikes in the summer term. The next scheduled strikes take place on:

- **Thursday 27th April 2023**
- **Tuesday 2nd May 2023**

As with the previous strikes, I can confirm the following arrangements:

- School will remain open to 'vulnerable' students and students whose parents/carers are key workers. If you are a key worker and need your child to come into school on these dates, please contact the school via email (enquiries@corecity.academy) to discuss this further.
- Students in Years 7-10 will receive remote learning through our well-established remote education provision, following the subjects they would usually have on those days. The details of this will be found by following the link: <https://tinyurl.com/4hs5xv2n> Students in these year groups should **not come into school on strike days**.
- Year 11 will attend school – Langley site – as normal. Due to staffing constraints, we will have a reduced day. School will open at 9.00am, with students finishing at 1.30pm. Lunch will be provided for all students. The staff in school will focus on preparing students for the exams in both Core and Option subjects across the two days. Students should attend in full school uniform. If you need your child to remain in school until 3.10pm, please contact us through the enquiries email, provided above.
